1. **HAMADDA (Knowledge):** Belief in God, Principles of faith, Proper behavior, Torah study, Idolatry, Repentance.
2. **AHAVAH (Love):** Love of God, Prayer, Tzitzis, Tefillin, and other Mitzvos.
3. **ZEMANIM (Times):** Shabbat and Jewish holidays.
4. **NASHIM (Women):** Marriage, divorce, infidelity.
5. **KEDUSHAH (Holiness):** Sexuality, Niddah, Incest and Adultery. Conversion. Kosher.
6. **HAFLA'AH (Separation):** Vows, oaths, Nazirites and donations to the temple.
7. **ZERA'IM (Seeds):** Agricultural laws, gifts to the poor, priests, tithes, secondary tithes, first fruits, Shemittah.
8. **AVODAH (Divine Service):** Laws of the Temple in Jerusalem.
9. **KORBANOT (Offerings):** Laws for offerings in the Temple, excepting those of the whole community.
10. **TOHORAH (Cleanness):** Ritual purity.
11. **NEZIKIN (Injuries):** Criminal and tort law.
12. **KINYAN (Acquisition):** Marketplace laws.
13. **MISHPATIM (Rights):** Civil law.
14. **SHOFETIM (Judges):** Laws relating to legislators, Sanhedrin, kings, judges, Noahide & for Messianic times.

1. **ORACH CHAYIM (Way of life):** Laws of Prayer; Synagogue; Sabbath; Holidays.
2. **YOREH DE'AH (Knowing Knowledge):** Laws of Kashruth; Conversion; Israel; Mourning; Family Purity.
3. **EVEN HA'EZER (Stone of Help):** Laws of Marriage, Divorce and related issues.
4. **CHOSHEN MISHPAT (Breastplate of Judgment):** Civil & Criminal Laws; Rules of the Bet Din; Witnesses.
